Music 3000 Expander - to double the power of the System, adding sixteen further sound channels and thus allowing you to use more voices and more complex instrument sounds. The Mixing Desk becomes twice as wide and automatically draws on the 3000's channels when all the 5000's channels are used.

AMPLE Toolbox software - to extend the operating software, including a Text Editor, Image Editor for creating screen graphics, Utilities for advanced program development, a sideways RAM module store (for the Master 128 only) and even a lost program recovery facility.

Universal Software Pack - to allow user BASIC or machine-code programs to drive the Music 5000 via the SOUND command, so now your other music software can be heard in Hybrid instrument sounds.

AMPLE Music Albums - 'Ashes', 'Shivering Again' and 'Electricity' are some recent additions to our growing range of discs offering pre-recorded music for all tastes; 'Windy Island' requires a Music 3000, and is an excellent demonstration of the 32-channel Hybrid System.

Details on the Music 2000 Interface for the control of MIDI instruments and drum machines, the ever-popular AMPLE Nucleus Programmer Guide, and a reminder of how to join the user-group AMPLINEX, are also enclosed.

Enjoy your Hybrid Music System. We look forward to keeping you in touch with developments and to hearing from you with your requirements.
